Boarding Rates:

Overnight "Pocket Pet" Boarding -> \$10.00 /day

Overnight Cat Boarding -> \$20.00 /day

Overnight Dog Boarding -> \$38.00 /day for the first dog, and \$35.00 /day for each additional dog

Boarding Add-ons:

Tracy's Food: We can provide food for your pet for an extra **\$2.00 /day** if needed or requested. We do recommend providing your pet's normal food for their stay because a sudden change in diet can often cause upset stomach or diarrhea. If your pet's provided food runs out part-way through their stay we will call to notify you and feed Tracy's Food until more food is provided; the \$2.00 /day fee would then only apply to the days we fed Tracy's Food.

Pictures + Videos: If you would like a picture or video of your pets during their stay with us you can let us know at drop off or give us a call. We will send you their pictures or video via text message or email at a fee of **\$5.00 /picture** and **\$10.00 /video**.

Playtimes + Walks: If you'd like your dog to get some extra exercise we do offer playtimes and walks for **\$6.00 /day for single dogs or \$5.00 /day for multiple dogs**. Playtimes take place in our fenced-in, outdoor yard one on one with a kennel attendant for about 20 minutes; if you have multiple dogs staying with us that get along well we will do their play time as a group. Walks are one on one with a kennel attendant on our property along a roughly $\frac{1}{2}$ of a mile, or 1,900ft, path.

Grooming: Our groomers here at Tracy's are more than happy to clean up your dog before they are picked up. Grooming services range from nail trims(\$18.00) to full grooms that include a bath, brush, cut, nail trim, ear cleaning, and gland expression. The price of grooming will vary depending on the size of the dog and what services the groomer is performing. Below are our approximate prices for a "Bath and Nails" which includes a bath, brush, ear cleaning, nail trim, and gland expression.

X-Small Dogs - \$40

Boarding Hours:

Monday - Saturday -> 8:00am-10:00am and 3:00pm-5:00pm

Sundays -> 3:00pm-7:00pm **only**

*There is a **\$40.00 Out of Hours Fee** if dropping off or picking up outside of these windows*

How we charge:

We charge like a hotel, you are charged the day you come in no matter what. On the day of pick up, if you pick up in the Am (8:00am-10:00am) you will not be charged for that day, If you pick up in the PM (3:00pm-5:00pm) you are charged for the day. Sunday while most kennels are closed, we do have PM hours (3:00pm-7:00pm) only, so you are charged for that day.

Additional Information:

All dogs that stay in our kennel must have the **Rabies, Distemper, and Bordetella vaccines** current for the full duration of their stay. If your reservation is a last minute ordeal, we can administer the Bordetella and Distemper vaccines for \$35.00 each the day of drop off. The Canine Influenza vaccine is not required by our facility but it is recommended for the overall well-being and health of your pet.

Special diets and medication are given at no extra charge, excluding insulin shots. **Insulin shots are \$5.00 /day**. Every section in our kennel has its own prep station with refrigerators, so fresh or canned diets can be kept fresh. If your pet has medications we ask that you only bring the amount necessary for their stay and package them in their own bag or container separate from their food. For instance, if you are pre-bagging their food for each meal do not put your dog's medications in those bags, even if they do typically eat it with their food. This way we can ensure your pet is taking their medication for you.

Our facility has everything your pet needs for their stay here with us. That includes Blankets, Beds, Dishes, and toys. You are more than welcome to bring your own things for them but we do ask you to please leave their food and water dishes at home, unless they require a slow feeder bowl. Otherwise we will supply the necessary bowls for them.

When bringing your own things we ask that you do not bring anything valuable from home. Meaning really nice beds or blankets. As much as we try to make it as comfortable as home, some dogs will chew their beds and blankets, even if they don't typically do so. If you have an old bed or blanket, that is also washable, that you don't mind something happening to, you are more than welcome to bring that.

You may pre-bag food into individual days or meals if you'd like, but you may also bring their food in the original bag that you bought it in, in a sealed container, in gallon ziploc bags, or tupperware containers. However it is convenient for you we can definitely work with. Again, please do not put medications in food bags. We want to make sure your pet gets the medications it needs when they need them. We ask that you please leave them in their proper medical containers, in a weekly/monthly organizer, or in a labeled bag.
